Welcome



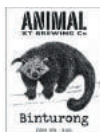

Cask Ale



1. Animal – **Binturong DDH IPA** 4.6% (22 beer miles)

A double dry-hopped Pale Ale from XT's experimental brewery. Gentle fruity nose, syrupy malt caramel citrus mouth, malty swallow before a dry grapefruit bitter finish.



2. Buntingford – **Twitchell** 3.8% (44 beer miles)

An easy drinking session golden fruity ale with a floral aroma light orange notes and a superbly balanced aftertaste. A solid all-round crowd pleaser.



3. Buntingford – **Polar Star** 4.4% (44 beer miles)

A heavily-hopped Blonde Ale with a truly refreshing citrus-hop kick and stellar finish. Pink grapefruit hop flavours abound in levels.



4. Chiltern – **Earl Grey IPA** 3.9% (12 beer miles)

More tea vicar? A pale citrus ale infused and flavoured with fragrant single origin Virunga Earl Grey tea from Birchall's East Africa Estate.



5. Chiltern – **Three Hundreds Old Ale** 3.9% (12 beer miles)

Satisfyingly dark but not impenetrable, good body but not overpowering, with a long pleasing finish. Exceptional balance of premium malt and choice English hops.














6. Farr Brew – **Farr Apart** 4.8% (16 beer miles)

The result of weeks of experiments and love for brewing. Dry hopped with large quantities of Mosaic hops this soft, juicy and fruity pale has a delicate haze and beautiful aroma.



7. Hornes – **Featherstone Amber Ale** 3.6% (25 beer miles)

A fruity amber session ale. Crystal and Cascade hops in the boil and dry hopped with even more Cascade make this little ABV beer pack a fruity punch.

8. Hornes – **Unlocked Hornes** 4.3% (25 beer miles)

Originally brewed as a 'one off' for the reopening of pubs after the lockdown. Unlocked Hornes is a citrusy refreshing session IPA, packed full of Citra and Simcoe hops.



9. Leighton Buzzard – **Golden Buzzard** 4.1% (16 beer miles)

Brewed just a few stops along the railway. A light, golden, crisp and refreshing session ale, brewed with Nelson Sauvin hops. This is hoppy, summer drinking that will see you soar!



10. Leighton Buzzard – **Vimy Bomber** 4.3% (16 beer miles)

A refreshing and tasty ruby-hued ale brewed with Bobek Goldings and Fuggles hops, leaving a full chocolate and coffee finish.



11. Loddon – **Citra Quad** 4.4% (32 beer miles)

Heavily hopped with Citra over four stages of the brewing process. The tropical, citrusy aromas are superbly propped up by heaps of oat malts for a smooth hazy session IPA.



12. Loddon – **Hocus Pocus** 4.6% (32 beer miles)

Rich, smooth and ruby in colour, Hocus Pocus is a proper Old Ale. English Golding and Fuggle hops plus Pale and Dark malts combine to form a rich, smooth traditional dark ale.



13. Mad Squirrel – **High Score IPL** 4.5% (3 beer miles)

A double whammy of lager balance and old school IPA impact. Early Pilsner malt slams make way for resinous hop blows to the taste buds and a clean finish.



14. New River – **Blind Poet** 3.9% (33 beer miles)

The blind poet George Dyer took an unplanned dip in the New River. The four malt varieties provide a lightly smoked, liquorice and chocolatey flavour.

15. New River – Five Inch Drop 3.9% (33 beer miles)
Hertfordshire Beer of the Year in 2019. This triple-hopped IPA has a toffee and malty aroma with pine resin and fruit citrus flavours.



16. New River – Riverbed Red 4.2% (33 beer miles)
A deep Ruby Ale with a resinous, malty and earthy aroma, supported by complex rich caramel flavours. An early taste of autumn.



17. New Wharf – Explorer 4.3% (23 beer miles)
A delicious and complex American Pale Ale. A well balanced, medium-bodied craft beer with notes of white grape, citrus and lemongrass.



18. New Wharf – Voyager 4.0% (23 beer miles)
A classic Amber Ale with a fine and complex aroma. A soft and luscious medium-bodied ale offering toffee and caramel richness with delicate floral hop notes for a clean finish.



19. Rebellion – Knock-On 3.4% (22 beer miles)
A well-balanced and extremely quaffable session copper coloured Pale Ale. Generously hopped with big and bold American varieties for a strong tropical fruit and citrus hit



20. Tring – Heroic Hawk 4.2% (5 beer miles)
Steely US Centennial hops take the lead in this bracingly bitter IPA. A stern malt backbone stays true to style with notes of citrus, mango and resin.



21. Tring – Squadron Scramble 4.0% (5 beer miles)
This ale is characterised by a debonair medium light colour and a dare-devil maltiness that compliments a courageous hop aroma from the best Mount Hood hops.

22. Vale – **Emperor** 4.1% (27 beer miles)

The August monthly brew from Vale. Hail, Caesar! Hop-forward flavours give this lavish blonde beer an impact that settles into cool, refined refreshment.



23. Vale – **Lock, Prop & Barrel** 3.9% (27 beer miles)

A tawny coloured highly quaffable ale. Brewed using six hops and six toasted malts with the Six Nations Championships in mind. A beer to savour wherever your loyalties lie!



24. Windsor & Eton – **Firefly** 4.0% (22 beer miles)

A seriously Blonde Ale for the summer brewed predominantly with lager malt. Cascade and Motueka hops give hints of melon and papaya.



25. Vale – **Orca** 4.5% (27 beer miles) – **Second Wave**

A bonus beer for the late evening from our previous glass sponsors Vale Brewery. A refreshing IPA that is citrusy with a hoppy bite and piney taste.

Low Alcohol Beer (cans)



Brewdog – **Hazy Jane** 0.5%

Say hello to the juiciest low alcohol beer in town. Tropical fruits and grassy notes mix it up. Oats and wheat unite for a smoother ride.



Brewdog – **Nanny State** 0.5%

A brigade of speciality malts and North American hops sends bitterness to the brink and back. Squeezing this many hops in, and the alcohol out, is a testament to Brewdog's craft.



Brewdog – **Punk IPA** 0.5%

A postmodern classic, reinvented. Juicy tropical fruit mixes it up with grassy and pine notes for a beer that's all flavour, no alcohol.

26. Tring – **Raven King** 5.5% (5 beer miles)

This powerful IPA brings waves of tropical fruits from Citra and Mosaic, dry-hopped for extra aroma. Brewed using wheat for a full-bodied, hazy finish.



27. Tring – **Alchemist** 4.4% ABV (5 beer miles)

Lightly-kilned malts are blended with noble hops Hersbrucker and Saaz for a lifting floral aroma. Finished with authentic lager yeast for notes of gentle spice and sweet grain.



28. Blackened Sun – **Aeon** 10.0% (28 beer miles)

Aeon is aged for seven months creating an inky, rich and bold Imperial Stout. This beer showcases the raw simplicity, flavours and accessibility you can create with this style.



29. Chiltern – **Chiltern Lager** 3.8% (12 beer miles)

A combination of the best of the biscuity, crisp, sweet malt that is characteristic of continental lagers with the more pronounced hop notes of American lagers. Gluten free too.



30. Creative Juices – **Slinky Vagabond** 5.6% (14 beer miles)

This heavy hopped IPA uses a blend of four new USA hop varieties to bring a layered flavour experience. The taste subtly moves from citrus to tropical to stone fruits.



31. Crossover Bendery – **Damascene** 6.3% (35 beer miles)

A blend of Golden Ales brewed with malted barley, rye and oats. Spontaneously fermented and aged in oak barrels. With Damascene damsons added for four month's refermentation.



32. Lost Boys – **New Eng IPA** 4.5% (13 beer miles)

NEIPA delivering a soft and silky taste of refreshing fruit. The dry hop approach leaves the beer with a light, hazy colour, less bitterness on the palate than from usual IPAs.

33. Mad Squirrel – Glacier Cold IPA 5.7% (3 beer miles)
Brewed cold using lager yeast and rice, making it super crushable and super crisp. Hopped with Talus and Nelson Sauvin giving notes of grape and citrus.



34. Mad Squirrel – Peach of my Heart 5.0% (3 beer miles)
Inspired by the famous dessert, a sweet peach sour with creamy vanilla notes and a tart raspberry twist. With real fruit puree and a little lactose for fruitiness and creaminess.



35. Panic Brew – Social Eduard 5.6% (16 beer miles)
Using Columbus in the kettle, Amarillo during active fermentation and Simcoe post-fermentation this DDH Pale Ale smacks both the taste buds and nostrils.



36. Rebellion – 24 Carat 5.0% (22 beer miles)
New World hops and a blend of traditional home-grown malted barley give this golden beer an intense, tropical aroma and a distinctive bittersweet flavour.



37. Tring – Drop Bar 4.0% (5 beer miles)

A slower, low temperature fermentation and dry hopping with Mosaic yields crisp flavours, subtle bitterness and a gentle floral, tropical fruit aroma.



38. Vale – Skyhopper 4.1% (27 beer miles)

This easy drinking session beer punches way above its ABV. All-English hops - Jester, Ernest, Admiral and UK Cascade - bring an explosion of zesty flavours.



39. XT Brewing Co – Squid Ink 5.5% (22 beer miles)

This bold beast of a black beer will whet your appetite with its complex blend of hops (Columbus, Summit, Pacific Gem and Chinook) and tsunami of nine malts.

40. Mad Squirrel – De La Maple 4.5% (3 beer miles)
A decadent balance of maple essence and lactose brings this sweet and sticky sensation to life. Clean maple notes with hints of vanilla and chocolate.



41. Mad Squirrel – Hopfest 3.8% (3 beer miles)
A new world gluten-free Pale Ale dedicated to bringing the very freshest, fruitiest hop vibes. Headlined by Citra, with Centennial and Amarillo, giving citrus refreshment.



42. Creative Juices– Ready for Love 4.3% (14 miles)
At a respectable 4.3%, Ready For Love punches well above its weight with its complexity of flavour. It's a refreshing double dry-hopped pale with attitude.



43. Blackened Sun – Metropolis 4.3% (28 beer miles)
A mash up of classic Kolsch and Pilsner. A simple malt backbone allows a firm hoppy bitterness from German and British hops. With a clean, crisp yeast character.



44. Panic Brew – Head Askew 5.8% (16 beer miles)
If Panic Brew were to name a beer they produce that encapsulates their sporadic approach to brewing – then this is it. Their favourite style of beer and hops.



45. Blackened Sun – Sunspots 4.6% (28 beer miles)
Blackened Sun's first hazy style Pale Ale. An easy drinking hop forward beer with tropical/citrus and berry fruit flavours, Sunspots is a very moreish beer.



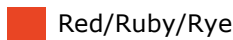
46. Mad Squirrel – Utopia 6.0% (3 beer miles)

A light, hoppy Pale Ale brewed with organic Maris Otter barley from Gloucestershire, regeneratively grown YQ from the brewery farm and Herefordshire grown hops.



48. Loddon – Ferryman's Gold 4.4% (32 beer miles)

A classic Golden Ale with zesty overtones, and a hint of grapefruit provided by Cascade and Slovenian hops. Supported by a biscuity backbone and caramel mouthfeel.



49. XT Brewing Co – Timber Wolf 4.7% (22 beer miles)

Packed with American hops (Columbus, Chinook, Amarillo and Mosaic) and double dry-hopped with Citra just to be on the safe side. Its a hazy, yellow golden, pale beer.



50. Windsor & Eton – Capital 4.0% (22 beer miles)

















Dry-hopped with Madarina Bavaria for its wonderful citrus fresh aroma and Lemon Drop for its zesty refreshing finish, Capital is a perfectly balanced session strength lager.















51. Tring – Lunardi's 4.2% ABV (5 beer miles)

A generous dose of oats adds a creamy texture. Gentle bitterness from Hersbrucker hops with Simcoe and Comet providing stone-fruit and mango aromas with a citrus finish.

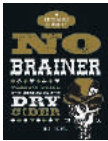
A. Celtic Marshes – Kings Tittle 4.5%

Berkshire traditional medium-dry cider, skilfully crafted and easily enjoyed. A full-strength west country style cider made from a blend of vintage quality apples.



G. Jars – Oak Goat 6.5%

A premium barrel-aged oak cider, made with single variety Yarlington Mill apples. Another fine dry cider from the Berkshire based cidery.

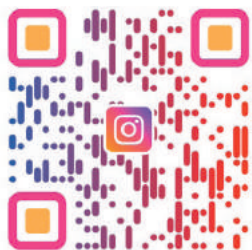

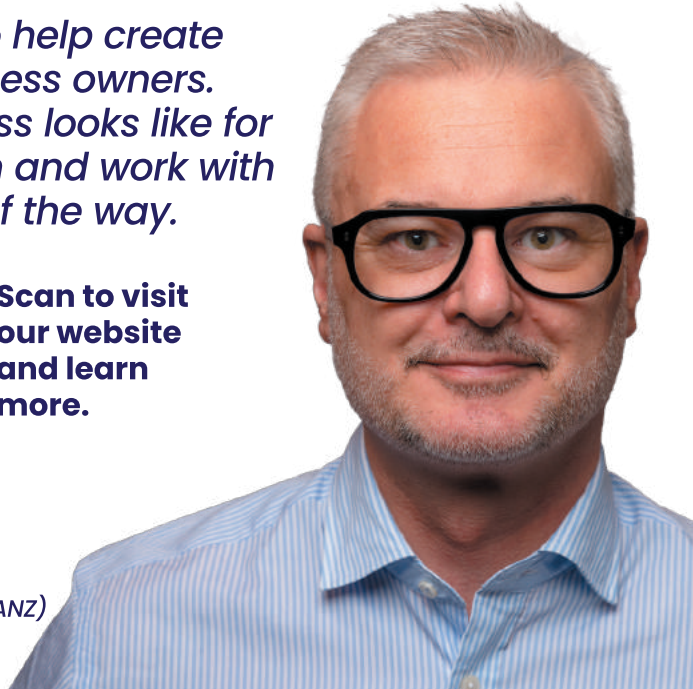
